NOTE: Vehicle Navigation Systems, Boogle & Fruit maps do not agree on the address for this property. They might get you in the right quadrant of the county.
The GPS coordinates for a service gate are 35.185618, -85.655803.

Directions to service gate of property from Boiling Springs, NC:

- Take NC 150 South. (Towards SC.) After Crossing the Broad river
- Turn left on Bachelor road. Bridges Riding equipment is on this corner. Proceed on Bachelor 0.5 miles.
- Turn left on Timber Drive. (first paved road.) BE CAREFUL! This is a left turn in a blind curve. (limited sight distance.) Travel 0.7 miles.
- The entrance is gated on the left side of the road. Due to a curve in the road, you will look like you are driving straight into the gate.

I will include a picture of the gate in the Troop leader / SPL addendum. This addendum will be distributed at a later date.

2018 SPRING Camporee Main notes:

- Potable water will NOT be available on site.
- Porta-johns will be available.
- Cell phone communication is marginal at best, unavailable at worst. Plan accordingly.
- 2 deep leadership for troops will be maintained and enforced. (There are extra leaders available, or we can combine troops.... Please don't let this be a reason for not attending.)
- LEAVE NO TRACE! Your troop will not be allowed to leave until the campsite you use is inspected by staff.
- The price per scout and leader is \$10.
- If weather permits, Campfires will be allowed in camping sites. A raised pit or digging to mineral earth will be required. Also each troop will need to have 20 gallons of water to douse flames. (4 x 5gal buckets) With a little work, Firewood is available. (logging has occurred near this area, and many branches and trees less than 3" diameter (and larger) are available.) Plan accordingly. (gloves, hand saws, axe etc.)
- Trailers may be moved into/near campsites and dropped. (We will have the ability to accommodate early trailer delivery... see addendum)
- No vehicles in campsites. (handicapped exceptions will be handled separately in advance)
- Troop campsite latrines are fine. Waste removed from site is preferred, but the Scout Handbook on latrines can be followed for hand dug latrines.
- Significant portions of the agenda and the individual Troop chores will be found in the Troop leader / SPL addendum (Hopefully this will go out in the next week.)
- There will be time available for Leaders for troops to improve camping areas. Just text me, and I can get you into the property. Campsites will be assigned, and troops can do preliminary site clearance if they so choose. 2 Deep Troop supplied leadership will be in effect.
- Non-staff Golf cart / ATV **MAY** be allowed (still under staff review) for Troop leader convenience. The cost will be \$10/vehicle.
