National Youth Leadership Training is an exciting, action-packed program, designed for Councils to provide youth members with leadership skills, and experience they can use in their home units and in other situations demanding leadership of self and others. Basic outdoor and cooking skills are necessary.

Each participant must hold or intend to hold a Troop or Crew leadership position. A Scout must have participated in Introductions to Leadership Skills for Troops (ILST) or Introduction to Leadership Skills for Crews (ILSC). All must be mature and responsible enough to spend six (6) full continuous days camping. Each participant must have his/her Parent's and Unit Leader's approval. Each Scout must be at least 14 years old or 13 years old and have completed the 8th grade.

All courses will be capped at eight patrols of six participants. (48 Scouts maximum)

DO NOT BRING:

Fireworks, sheath knives, tobacco products, laser pointers, video games or similar items. Cell Phones may be used according to Course guidelines. Each participant must have a current Cyber Chip (renewed annually).

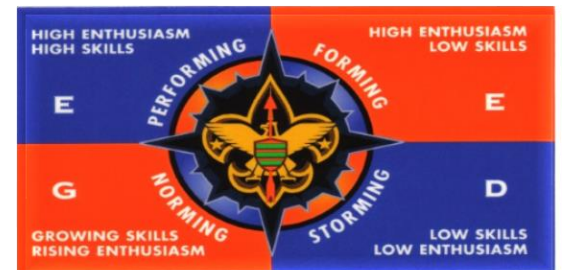
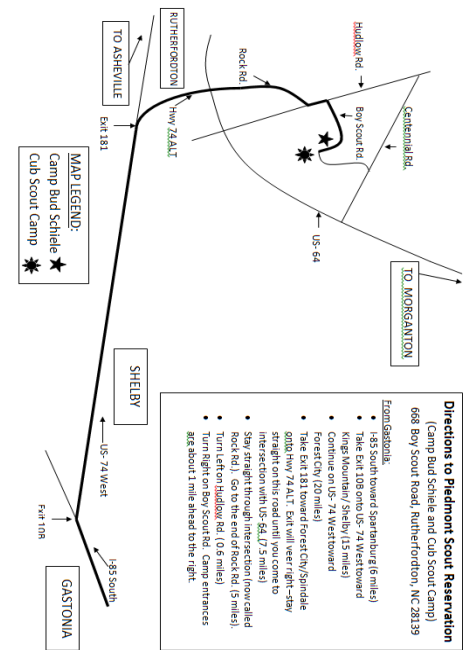
