

Welcome to the Lakeland District Day Camp

This year camp will be held at Mt. Zion Lutheran Church, 4420 County Home Rd, Conover, NC, the week of June 17-21, 2019, between the hours of 8:30 A.M. to 3:00 P.M, Mon thru Thurs, and 8:30 A.M. -1:00 P.M. on Friday.

Pick Up and Drop Off

Please do not drop your child off before 8:15 A.M. I ask that you please have your scout there on time in the mornings and picked up on time in the afternoon. If your scout is going to be late, please bring him to the office and hand sign him in. The same applies if you need to pick him up early, you must come to the office and sign him out. You may send a note for early dismissal and we will have him ready in the office to go, for when you arrive. No one will be allowed to park during the afternoon carpool line and walk up to pick up their scout. Parents are more than welcome to come and visit with their scout(s) during the day, just make sure you sign in at the office first before trying to locate him.

Items to bring and not to bring with you to Camp:

- Your day camp tee shirt to be worn every day all day long. It is MANDATORY they wear their shirts daily. If your scout(s) show up to camp without it, you will have to buy a new one. The cost is \$10.00.
- Towel. They will get wet on Thursday and Friday!!!!
- Water Bottle with name on it and carry all day long. Ice water will be offered to refill water bottles often. You can order a Cub Scout Day Camp Water Bottle Online.
- Your scout will need to bring a bag lunch from home every day except Friday. We will have coolers to store them in on sight, but please take into consideration we are outside and pack food that will not spoil easily. Please feed your camper breakfast each morning.
- No flip flops, crocks, or open toed shoes (too many scrapes and falls with these types of shoes), No Bare Feet.
- Backpack or old Book bag to put all of their items in to keep them all together, with name on it.
- If medication needs to be administered while at camp, it needs to be given to the camp director, we need to keep it stored in a locked location, please bring a SIGNED statement giving permission for us to administer his medicine. All Meds are to be in their original container with prescription label. Our Camp Medic will see that your scout takes his medication.
- Do not bring Knives, BB guns, Sling shots, DRUGS, any of the Monster type drinks, toys, money, Matches, or any type of weapon.
- NO VIDEO GAMES or electronics or fidget spinners, please. They will be taken and returned at the end of the day.
- Sun screen. Do not forget to apply sunscreen in the morning and send extra to be reapplied during the day. The boys will be outside all day and it will be very hot!
- Cap or Hat, with name on it.
- We will have Catawba County EMS on site to treat scrapes and cuts, Band aids, etc...
- BSA Health Form Part A & B -Bring to Orientation Meeting.

Please remember Safety, Safety, Safety. Your child will be cared for as if they were my own, and I will take privileges of campers for any violation of Camp, BSA, and the Laws of NC (parents will be told of minor infractions, and called for major violations, up and to dismissing the child for the rest of the day or week depending on severity), there will be no fighting, horse play or rough handling by anyone. No Soft Drinks please, it only makes them thirstier and I want them to drink plenty of water.

***Do not forget – there is a mandatory drop-in orientation and pre-camp check-in held on Sunday, June 16 from 3:00 P.M. to 5:00 P.M. at Mt. Zion Lutheran Church. You will be given your scout's camp T-shirt and other information. On this day you will get a chance to meet with your scout's den leader and get a chance to ask any questions or tell us any of your concerns or special needs that may apply to your scout.
